Winter Maintenance Tips

As the leaves start to fall and Winter is just around the corner, we would like to provide you with a few helpful tips for preparing your home and yard for the cold months ahead!

- Have your furnace inspected to ensure it is clean and in good working condition
- Check your roof for damage or loose or missing shingles that may leak during Winter storms or from melting snow
- Caulk around windows and door frames to prevent drafts and leaks, and apply weather stripping around doors as needed
- Clean gutters of leaves and other debris to avoid water backing up, leaks, or ice damming
- Add extensions to downspouts so water runs at least three to four feet from your foundation
- Turn off exterior faucets and disconnect and drain the hoses and faucets, as un-drained pipes may freeze. If your faucets are not frost proof, it is recommended to turn off the valve in the basement
- Note: if you are heading out of town for 3 or more consecutive days, please remember to turn off your water and drain your pipes, or ask a reliable person to check on your home daily while you are away!
- Drain your lawn irrigation system to avoid freezing or leaks.
- Instead of raking, mulch your leaves and as they decompose they will nourish the lawn over Winter.
- Have your chimney and vents cleaned to ensure they are in good repair before use to prevent fires and carbon monoxide from getting into your home.
- Restock your Winter essentials, such as salt, ice melt, and shovels!
